Antarctica

The highlight of the voyage is a visit to Cape Denison, the windiest place on the earth. It is the site of the first Australian scientific base in the Antarctic. The voyage also takes you to Port Martin, where you can view 100 grounded icebergs, and Dumont d'Urville, the French base famous for its colonies of Adelie and Emperor penguins.

Macquarie Island

It became a World Heritage Site in 1997, and is often called one of the wonder spots of the world.
