B Stone Circles in Ooyu, Akita prefecture, date back to about four thousand years ago. Surrounded by ancient structural remnants, two or more stone circles are set within one another. These unique circles look like sundials and are believed to be both burial sites and ceremonial sites. A stone circle is positioned so that one can see the sun set on the “sundial” from the center of the largest circle on the day marking midsummer.
